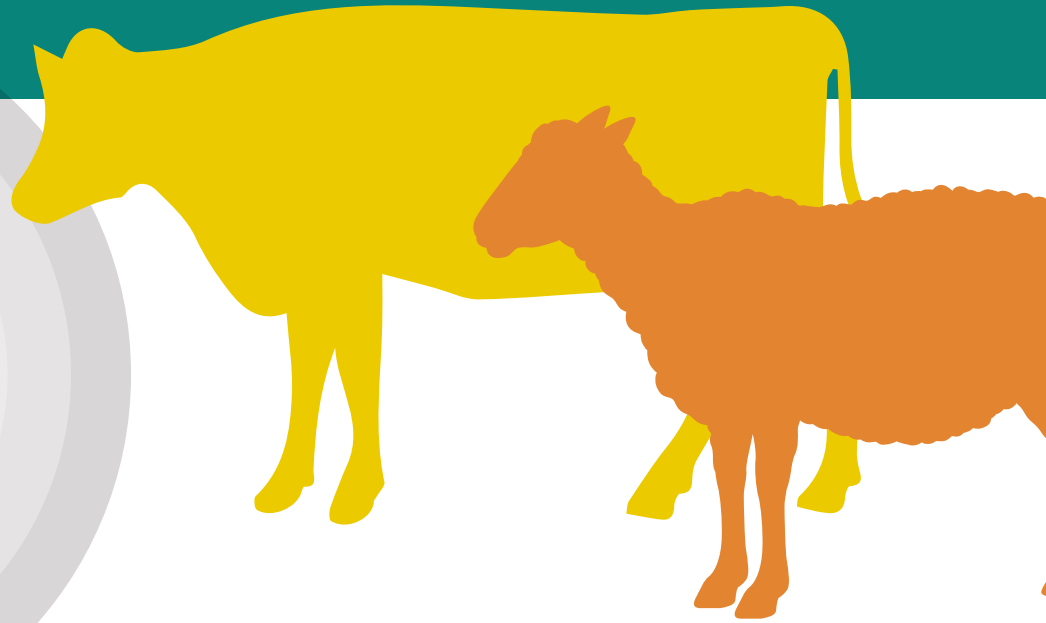

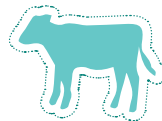

Lower fertility

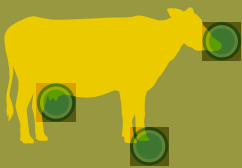


Denied access to markets
