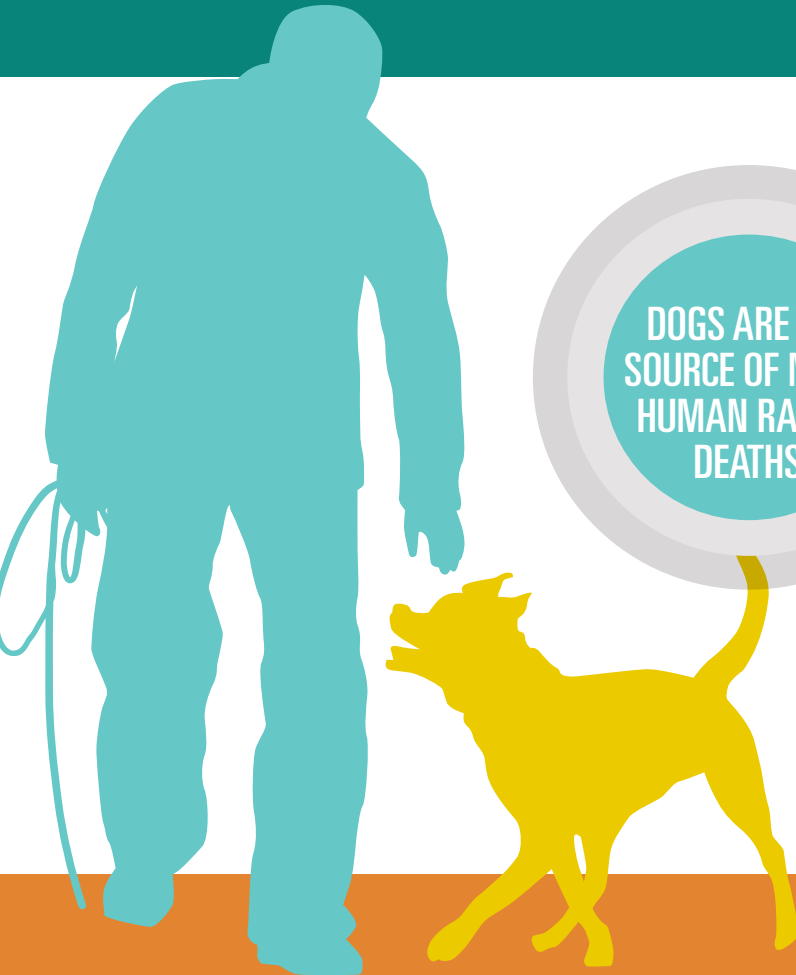


# PROTECTING YOUR DOGS —AND YOURSELF— FROM RABIES

AND ANIMALS

## Signs in Animals

Aggression  
or Unusual  
Behavior

Excessive  
Salivation

Choking or  
Gagging

## Rabies is Spread

through infected saliva, usually  
through bite wounds



## If You are Exposed to Rabies



Wash wound with  
soap and water



Tell a doctor

## CONTROLLING RABIES



Vaccination



Notify authorities of  
suspected cases



Prevent dogs from  
roaming free
